PAPER FORMAT

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Abstract— This document gives formatting instructions for authors preparing papers for publication in IJRRR. The authors must follow the instructions given in the document for the papers to be published. You can use this document as both an instruction set and as a template into which you can type your own text.

Keywords— Put your keywords here, keywords are separated by comma.

I. INTRODUCTION

This document is a template. An electronic copy can be downloaded from the conference website. For questions on paper guidelines, please contact the conference publications committee as indicated on the conference website. Information about final paper submission is available from the conference website. The text must be in English. Plagiarism is strictly unacceptable. The submitted typeset scripts of each contribution must be in their final form and of good appearance.

II. PAGE LAYOUT

A. Page Layout

Your paper must use a page size corresponding to A4 which is 21 cm wide and 29.7cm long. The margins must be set as follows:

- Top = 1.9 cm
- Bottom = 4.3 cm
- Left = Right = 1.43 cm

Your paper must be in two column format with a space of 1.14 cm between columns.

III. PAGE STYLE

All paragraphs must be indented. All paragraphs must be justified, i.e. both left-justified and right-justified and have line spacing of 1.15.

A. Text Font of Entire Document

The entire document should be in Times New Roman.

Recommended font sizes are shown in Table 1.

B. Title and Author Details

Title must be in 18 pt Regular font. Author name must be in 12 pt Regular font. Author affiliation must be in 11 pt Italic. Email address must be in 10 pt.

All title and author details must be in single-column format and must be centered. Every word in a title must be capitalized except for short minor words such as "a", "an", "and", "as", "at", "by", "for", "from", "if", "in", "into", "on", "or", "of", "the", "to", "with".

Each affiliation must include, at the very least, the name of the company and the name of the country where the author is based (e.g. xyz, Japan).

Email address is compulsory for the corresponding author.

C. Figures

Figures must be centered in the column. Large figures and tables may span across both columns. Any table or figure that takes up more than 1 column width must be positioned either at the top or at the bottom of the page.




Fig. 1 A sample line graph using colors which contrast well both on screen and on a black-and-white hardcopy

Graphics may be full color. Graphics must not use stipple fill patterns because they may not be reproduced properly. Please use only *SOLID FILL* colors which contrast well both on screen and on a black-and-white hardcopy, as shown in Fig. 1.

Fig. 2 shows an example of an image with adequate resolution. Check that the resolution is adequate to reveal the important detail in the figure.

Please check all figures in your paper both on screen and on a black-and-white hardcopy. When you check your paper on a black-and-white hardcopy, please ensure that:

- the colors used in each figure contrast well,
- the image used in each figure is clear,
- all text labels in each figure are legible.

D. Figure Captions

Figures must be numbered using Arabic numerals. Figure captions must be in 10 pt Regular font. Captions of a single line (e.g. Fig. 2) must be centered whereas multi-line captions must be justified (e.g. Fig. 1). Captions with figure numbers must be placed after their associated figures, as shown in Fig. 1.

E. Table and TableCaptions

Tables must be centered in the column. The text in the table is in size of 10 pt.

Table captions must be centred and in 11 pt Regular font with numbered using uppercase Roman numerals. Table numbers must be placed before their associated tables, as shown in Table 1.

F. Page Numbers, Headers and Footers

Page numbers, headers and footers must not be used.

G. Links and Bookmarks

All hypertext links and section bookmarks will be removed from papers during the processing of papers for publication. If you need to refer to an Internet email address or URL in your paper, you must type out the address or URL fully in Regular font.

H. Equations

All equations must be typed or written neatly in black. They should be numbered consecutively throughout the text. Equation numbers should be enclosed in parentheses and flushed right. Equations should be referred to as Eq. (X) in the text where X is the equation number. In multiple-line equations, the number should be given on the last line.

IV CONCLUSIONS

The better you write your paper, the better the Journal looks. Thanks for your cooperation and contribution. This is the acceptable format.

V ACKNOWLEDGMENT

The heading of the Acknowledgment section and the References section must not be numbered.

V REFERENCES

The heading of the References section must not be numbered. All reference items must be in 9 pt font. Please use Regular and Italic styles to distinguish different fields as shown in the References section. Number the reference items consecutively in square brackets (e.g. [1]).

When referring to a reference item, please simply use the reference number, as in [2]. Do not use "Ref. [3]" or "Reference [3]" except at the beginning of a sentence, e.g. "Reference [3] shows ...". Multiple references are each numbered with separate brackets (e.g. [2], [3], [4]–[6]).

Examples of reference items of different categories shown in the References section include:

- example of a book in [1]
- example of a book in a series in [2]
- example of a journal article in [3]

- example of a conference paper in [4]
- example of a patent in [5]
- example of a website in [6]
